10月15日,聯邦勞工部副部長盧沛 寧(Chris P.Lu)蒞臨哥倫布市,與當地亞裔 社區的領袖和骨幹親切會面,一起交流亞 裔參政議政的重要性。盧沛寧在俄亥俄長 大,是目前奧巴馬政府中級別最高的亞裔 官員。他曾經負責籌建第一屆奧巴馬政府 班子,并擔任內閣秘書(Cabinet Secretary)。參加會面的有近 100 人,包括華裔、 日裔、朝鮮裔、印度裔和菲律賓裔;有上世 紀60年代到美國留學的第一代老移民, 也有90后出生的第二代移民,充分的反 映了俄州亞裔社區的多樣性。

俄亥俄前任州長 Ted Strickland 的夫 人 Frances 也參加了會面,并即興給大家 用吉他演奏了她自己創作的為 Ted 助選 聯邦議員的歌曲。
